Private sector IR35 reform is just around the corner. After a year-long delay, we canvassed the thoughts of employers and contractors to gain a better understanding of their position ahead of the change. Approaches to the reforms are mixed, as is the messaging surrounding it, but there is a clear and evident path forward for those looking to continue making the most of contract talent.

9 in 10 contractors

are worried about reduced income post-IR35 reform. It is estimated that around 170,000 contractors will end up with a bigger tax bill, averaging an extra

More than half (55%) of UK contractors said they would be more open to contracting opportunities outside of the UK following changes to legislation.

£410,000,000

of additional tax revenue has been generated by IR35 legislation in public sector contracting, according to the UK Government. In comparison, Amazon paid £293m in tax on revenue of £13.7 billion last year, and will continue to avoid the UK's digital services tax.

believe that opportunities will decrease once IR35 reform is introduced to the private sector in April.

reported an increase in remote working over the past 12 months. While rules on being in the office will eventually change, many aspects of flexible working are likely to stick around in the post-pandemic world, which can drastically alter an IR35 determination.
