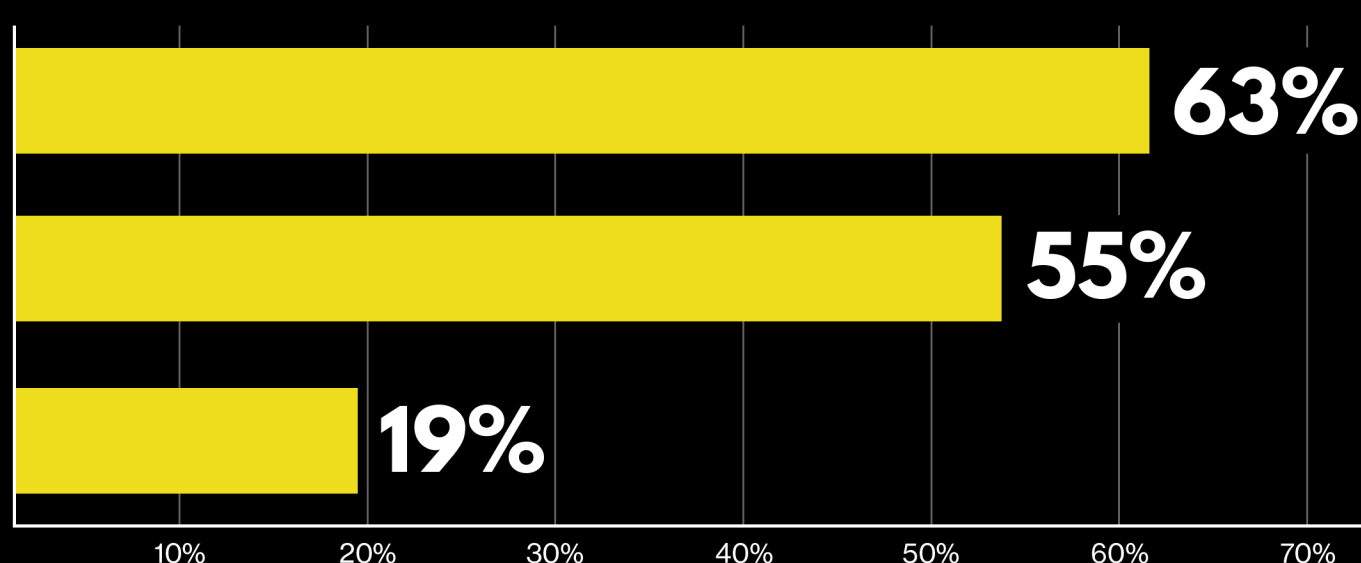

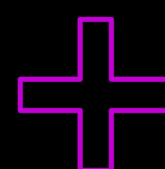
what OS do you use Go on?



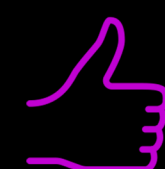

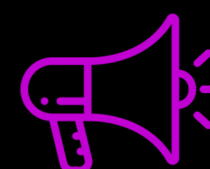

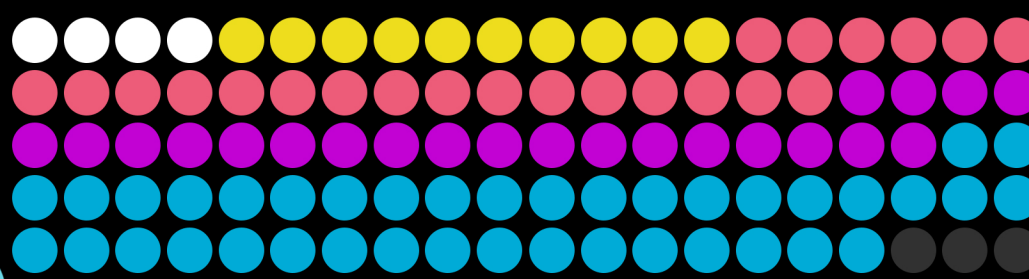
